

RRM Registration Process

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Overview of the registration process

IDENTIFICATION

- MPs CEREMP
- Others online identification form (similar to Sec. 1 &2 of MPs form)
- ACER verifies identity and issues credentials

TECHNICAL SPECS

- Login with ACER's credentials
- Online signature of NDA
- Download technical specs

DECLARATION

- Declaration of fulfilment of requirements on security and timely transmission, input validation, output content, format & validation
- Undertaking to comply with other requirements

TESTING

- Reporting of data using test environment
- Successful reporting of a certain % of transactions per data type

REGISTRATION

- Credentials for access to production environment issued
- Registration process completed
- Reporting of data to production environment

RRM User Group

- Members are pre-registered and registered RRMs
- Regular meetings (webinars, live meetings)
- Providing a possibility to discuss on potential issues and share experience
- Allowing ACER to communicate with the User Group rather than each RRM individually, when appropriate and necessary
- Providing a way to discuss potential changes, improvements and further evolution of ARIS



Current status on RRM registration

- 20 third party RRMs registered so far.
- More than 450 MPs applied to become RRMs.
- More than 30 third party RRMs still in the process of registration as RRM.
- Testing environment is open continuously also to RRMs that have been approved. More than 6 million records (standard trades and orders) have been submitted so far into test environment.



Post go-live activities

• RRMs:

- Ensure data collection runs smoothly
- Ensure MPs are informed about potential issues with the data
- Ensure proper communication channels with the Agency are in place

MPs:

- Select a RRM.
- Engage when corrections/resubmissions are required

ACER:

- Work on further improvements of ARIS
- Monitor the quality of data submitted
- Prepare for 2nd phase of reporting
